FEATURES

GRASS
(monocot)

barley, corn, rice, rye, wheat, wild rice, oats, bamboo, lemongrass

blade shaped leaves with parallel veins, leaves in sets of 2, inflorescences spikes/ panicle

LILY
Grass like allium
(monocot)

onion, garlic, leeks, shallots, scallions, asparagus, ramps, tulips, amaryllis

grass like, parallel veins in leaf, leaves in sets of three, flowers in sets of three, 6 pointed blooms

CARROT
(parsley)

carrots, celery, cilantro, fennel, parsley, parsnips, anise, dill

umbrella shaped inflorescences, hollow stems, aromatic

MINT

basil, lavender, oregano, rosemary, sage, thyme, mint

square stems, aromatic, opposite leaves, two lipped flora

SUNFLOWER
(daisy)

artichokes, burdock, chicory, endives, tarragon, lettuces, cardoons, sun chokes

flower head composite

KNOTWEED
(buckwheat)

rhubarb, sorrel, buckwheat

most perennial, swollen nodes, alternate simple leaves

CABBAGE
(mustard)

cabbage, arugula, broccoli, cauliflower, collards, kale, turnips, Brussels sprouts, kohlrabi, mustard, radish, bok choy

cross shaped flowers

NIGHTSHADE

potatoes, eggplant, tomato, bell peppers, hot peppers, tomatillos

star shaped flowers, fruit berry - capsule

AMARANTH

cereal amaranth, ornamental amaranth

red stem, inflorescences spikes

GOOSEFOOT

beets, spinach, quinoa, chard,

leaf shaped like goosefoot

CUCUBRIT
(gourd)

cucumbers, pumpkins, melons, gourds, squash,

stems five sided, hairy, with tendrils

LEGUME
(pea)

peas, green beans, garbanzo, fava, dried beans, soybeans, lentils

flowers boat like, fruits are pods, root nodules, compound stipulated leaves

**MORNING
GLORY**

sweet potatoes, morning glory

trumpet shaped flowers, heart shaped leaves
